TO ALL MEMBERS OF THE ALGONQUINS OF PIKWÀKANAGÀN FIRST NATION:

Please find enclosed 2 Application Forms for this years' 2013-2014 harvest. The first application is for an Elk Tag Draw and the second is a Moose Tag Draw. Also, for your information we have attached a summary page on the First Nations Lands Management Act (FNLMA).

You are eligible to harvest an **Elk and/or Moose** however you must be the age of 18 years by the deadline of your applicant submission.

Elk Tag Draw: Deadline for submitting the application for the Elk Tag Draw is: **August 27, 2013 at 12:00 p.m.** The Elk Tag Draw will be held on: **August 29, 2013 at 2:00 p.m.** in Council Chambers. The Elk Harvest will start on September 1, 2013 until January 15, 2014. (Note there will be no Calf Elk Tags Issued). Harvest Area will be marked out on map.

Moose Tag Draw: Deadline for submitting the application for the Moose Tag Draw is: **Sept. 3, 2013 at 12:00 p.m.** The Moose Tag Draw will be held on: **September 6, 2013 at 2 p.m.** in Council Chambers. The Moose Harvest will start on October 15, 2013 until January 15, 2014 but the Cows will end December 20, 2013.

For Moose only please enter on the enclosed application form your preference for the first and second choice of WMU's which you would like to harvest in. The WMU's are WMU #41, WMU #51 (Algonquin Park), and WMU #48, WMU #55-A, WMU #55-B, WMU #57, WMU #61, WMU #63-A, WMU #63-B, and WMU #65. Please refer to MNR Hunting Regulations for these locations.

Tags will be available for issuance on August 30, 2013 for the Elk Tags, and the Moose Tag will be available for issuance on September 12, 2013 between the hours of 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. (Monday to Friday-Admin. Building).(Dates for issuance may be subject to change) Moose Tags will be issued one weekend, this being Saturday, September 28, 2013 between the hours of 11:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. All other relevant information will be handed out at the time of tag issuance.
